BLUE MOON:

Tuition Centre:

The Blue Moon project was started in the year 2016. The project aims to provide quality handholding to children of economically poor and vulnerable families in around Kurusukuppam a coastal town in the UT of puducherry. The centre was inaugurated with 9 children. Students are given adequate guidance and support by qualified teachers to prepare the home assignments and compete for their academic excellence. During the school vacation the children are given assignments like handwriting, reading, GK, Drawing, storytelling, etc. In addition the children are given awareness on child rights and protection, environmental conservation, gardening, etc.



Day Care centre:

The day care centre was established in the month of July 2016. Children who hail from poor and weaker economic families are given day care shelter. The children engaged actively with play way method of teaching. Children during their stay in the centre are provided nutritious snacks.



JAL SENIOR HOME:

JAL senior home was established with an objective to provide care and support to the sick, aged, destitute and the abandoned elders. The home was established in the month of September 2016. The inmates are given free clothing, food and accommodation. At present there are.....seniors in the home. Regular counseling and medical checkups are done to provide emotional support and monitor their health conditions. The inmates are taken out to excursion to beach and other tourist places.

CASE STUDY 1:

Krishnamoorthy aged around 75 years old worked as a watchman and supported his family. Krishnamoorthy was suffering from poor eye sight and lost his job due to this. Later when he consulted the doctor he was advised for cataract operation. Because of poor eye sight he was denied job and finally landed in begging. JAL team found him when he was begging in the street, later he was intervened and was referred to Certh India hospital for free cataract treatment. Krishnamoorthy after the operation got job and continues to support his family members.



CASE STUDY 2:

Pachaiyammal aged around 70 years was living with her daughter family in Solai Nagar, Puducherry. During night time she comes out her house and couldn't find her way to return home. Later she was identified by the JAL volunteer was given shelter, food, and clothing in the Senior home after informing the local police station. Meanwhile when the family members were looking for her could not find her and later landed in the police station to give missing complaint. Then the family members were informed that she was rescued safely and admitted in JAL senior home. The family arrived to JAL senior home. They were given parental guidance and later she was restored with her family members. The family members thanked JAL for the support.



CASE STUDY 3:

Rajammal aged around 75 years lives with her family in Chunambedu, Tindivanam . Rajammal along with her family members came for a marriage function in Pondicherry but however lost and was found walking near Krishna Nagar. On receipt of the information about the elder JAL team arrived to the spot and interacted with her. Later she was brought to JAL home and was given shelter, food and clothing after informing to the local police station. Since her family members didn't turned up for long time, she was taken to her native and later she was restored with her family members.
